Bulger was found living quietly in a rent-controlled Santa Monica apartment with over \$800,000 in cash hidden in the walls — despite being one of the FBI’s Most Wanted fugitives.
2. What future entertainment venue was completed in Greenwich, London in June 1999?	2. The Millennium Dome (now The O2)	2. Once ridiculed as a white elephant after hosting the controversial Millennium Experience, the Dome was reborn as The O2 — now one of the world’s busiest music venues
3. Which American actress and former child star died of an overdose at age 47 on 22 June 1969?	3. Judy Garland	3. Though celebrated for her role as Dorothy in The Wizard of Oz, Garland’s life was marked by hardship — her overdose in London ended a career that saw both Hollywood triumph and personal tragedy.
4. Which actress left Tom Cruise after 6 years of marriage in June 2012?	4. Katie Holmes	4. Her high-profile split from Tom Cruise was executed with military precision — she reportedly used disposable phones and surprise legal filings to avoid interference from Cruise’s Scientology circle.
5. What first-generation technology did Apple launch on 29 June 2007, with people queuing for days?	5. The iPhone	5. When Apple launched the iPhone, it not only revolutionized phones — it reinvented how we take photos, browse the web, communicate, shop, and even work. It sold over 6 million units before the next model arrived.
6. Which Oscar-winning actress, known for The African Queen and On Golden Pond, died at age 96 on 29 June 2003?	6. Katharine Hepburn	6. Holding the record for most Best Actress Oscars (4), Hepburn defied Hollywood norms with her fiercely independent spirit, famously refusing to conform to studio rules or gender expectations.
7. Which singer fell 50ft from a stage bridge in Munich, Germany, during a performance in June 1999?	7. Michael Jackson	7. Jackson plummeted 50 feet after a stage bridge collapsed during Earth Song in Munich — astonishingly, he completed the concert despite suffering a damaged spine and broken foot.
8. Which two musicians were jailed for drug offences but avoided prison after appeals in June 1967?	8. Mick Jagger and Keith Richards	8. Their 1967 drug arrests at Jagger’s country estate became a flashpoint in the clash between counterculture and the British establishment — prompting a Times editorial titled “Who Breaks a Butterfly on a Wheel?”
9. Which 'blonde bombshell' actress married playwright Arthur Miller on 29 June 1956?	9. Marilyn Monroe	9. The Monroe-Miller marriage stunned the public — the glamorous star and the cerebral playwright made headlines worldwide, though their relationship crumbled amid professional pressures and FBI scrutiny of Miller.
10. What theatre was destroyed by fire during a performance of Henry VIII in June 1613?	10. The Globe Theatre	10. The original Globe burned to the ground when a theatrical cannon misfired during a performance of Henry VIII — but thanks to its wooden structure, no deaths were recorded, and it was rebuilt within a year.
11. Which UK Prime Minister left the D-Day 80th anniversary early, causing outrage in June 2024?	11. Rishi Sunak	11. Leaving early for a TV interview sparked fury across the political spectrum — forcing Sunak to apologize amid accusations of disrespecting veterans and mishandling the moment.
12. Whose statue was pulled down in Bristol in June 2020 due to his ties to the slave trade?	12. Edward Colston	12. The toppling of Colston’s statue during a Black Lives Matter protest became a defining image of 2020, reigniting debates about how Britain confronts its colonial and slave-trading past.
