

- Earuce the Shark The mechanical shark was nicknamed "Bruce" after director Steven Spielberg's lawyer. (He later inspired the shark in Finding Nemo!)
- Mechanical Mayhem The shark frequently malfunctioned, which forced Spielberg to suggest the threat instead of showing it—a choice that made the film even scarier.
- 3. The First Blockbuster Jaws became the first film to earn over \$100 million, creating the blueprint for the modern summer blockbuster.
- 4. IJust Two Notes Composer John Williams created the iconic theme using just two alternating notes. Spielberg thought it was a joke at first—until he realized it was terrifying.
- 6. Filmed at Sea (a Nightmare) Instead of using a tank, Spielberg chose to shoot in the open ocean, causing delays, seasickness, and endless technical issues.
