- Recycled Footage The shark's death in the revised international ending reuses footage from the original Jaws (1975), showing the shark's corpse sinking in nearly identical fashion.
- Michael Caine's Scheduling Conflict Michael Caine (Hoagie) missed accepting his first Academy Award for Hannah and Her Sisters because he was filming Jaws: The Revenge. When asked about it, he famously said, "I have never seen it, but by all accounts it is terrible."
