✓ Answer: 1971
- How many bones are there in the adult human body?
✓ Answer: 206
- How many official languages are there in Switzerland?
✓ Answer: 4
➤ German, French, Italian, and Romansh
- How many U.S. presidents have been assassinated while in office?
✓ Answer: 4
➤ Abraham Lincoln (1865), James A. Garfield (1881), William McKinley (1901), and John F. Kennedy (1963)
- How many countries share a border with Germany?
✓ Answer: 9
➤ Denmark, Poland, Czech Republic, Austria, Switzerland, France, Luxembourg, Belgium, and the Netherlands.
- How many dimples are there on a standard golf ball?
✓ Answer: Typically 336
- What is the maximum number of moves needed to solve a Rubik's Cube from any position?
✓ Answer: 20 – known as "God's Number"
- How many time zones does Russia span?
✓ Answer: 11
- How many episodes of Friends were there?
✓ Answer: 236
- In what year was the first FIFA World Cup held?
✓ Answer: 1930
