





- Jon Bernthal (Shane) knew from the start that his character would die in Season 2.
- Shane's descent into instability was expanded beyond the comics.
- of The scene where Rick kills walker Sophia was filmed in a single take.
- 📀 Chandler Riggs (Carl) performed many of his own stunts, despite his young age.
- 🤫 The barn massacre sequence was choreographed over two weeks.
- 🙏 Hershel was portrayed as more religious and peaceful than his comic counterpart
- Daryl's "Cherokee Rose" speech was a heartfelt addition not in the comics.
- 🌘 Real animal organs and meat were used to enhance the realism of walker kills.
- heavily Frank Darabont was fired during Season 2 production, despite creating the show.
- Glenn and Maggie's romance began earlier in the show than in the comics.
- 6 Hershel's walker wife was portrayed by a stuntwoman in full prosthetics.
- 2 The episode "18 Miles Out" was shot with handheld cameras for a gritty effect.
- The group stayed on the farm longer due to fan love for the setting.
- Mane and Rick's final confrontation was filmed over two full days.
- The prison is teased in the final shot of the Season 2 finale.
- 🧺 Andrew Lincoln stayed in character as Rick even between takes.
- **!** Jeffrey DeMunn (Dale) asked to be written off after Darabont was fired.
- 🐾 Walker herds were inspired by real animal migration behaviour.
- Each walker had its own backstory created by the makeup and costume departments.
- 🛼 Rick's quote "This is not a democracy anymore" became an iconic line.
- ♦ Season 2 reveals that everyone is infected, regardless of being bitten


