







- Michonne's katana was a real (but dulled) sword used for close-up scenes.
- Woodbury was filmed in the real town of Senoia, Georgia.
- Andrea's comic storyline was instead adapted for Carol in the TV version.
- The Governor's eye patch was directly inspired by the comic book character design.
- 🔙 Merle returned this season after being absent since early Season 1.
- 🦒 Hershel's leg amputation was one of the most shocking moments of the season.
- **\$\rightarrow\$** Lori died giving birth to Judith, diverging significantly from her comic fate.
- 🤾 Rick began hallucinating Lori after her death, symbolizing his grief.
- Danai Gurira trained extensively in sword fighting before filming began.
- Lennie James improvised many emotional lines as Morgan.
- 🤫 Merle's death was filmed secretly to avoid leaks.
- The Governor's real name was revealed as Philip Blake.
- Andrea died in the finale, a major change from her long-running comic role.
- 😥 Laurie Holden didn't learn Andrea would die until late in production.
- Milton, the Governor's scientist, was created specifically for the show.
- Michonne and the Governor's fight scene was rehearsed for over a week.
- 🕹 Baby Judith was played by twin girls, switching out between scenes.
- Andrea was originally meant to survive, but the script was changed during production.
