1. How long does sunlight take to reach Earth - 8 minutes, 57 minutes or 122 minutes?	1. 8 minutes	1. ☀️ Sunlight takes about 8 minutes and 20 seconds to travel the 93 million miles to Earth at the speed of light.
2. On average, how many minutes does it take a person to fall asleep - 7 minutes, 14 minutes or 21 minutes?	2. 14 minutes	2. 🛌 The average person falls asleep in about 14 minutes, although this varies based on many factors like stress and environment.
3. Which body part can Harry Potter actor Daniel Radcliffe reportedly twist 260 degrees - His arm, His leg or His head?	3. His arm	3. 🧑 Daniel Radcliffe has hypermobile shoulders and can reportedly rotate his arm 260 degrees — a fun party trick, not dark magic!
4. What do the numbers on opposite sides of a standard die add up to?	4. 7	4. 🎲 The numbers on opposite sides of a standard six-sided die always add up to 7 (1-6, 2-5, 3-4).
5. True or False: The world’s longest mountain range is underwater.	5. True	5. 🌊 The Mid-Ocean Ridge is the longest mountain range in the world — and it's entirely underwater, stretching over 65,000 km.
6. How many verses are in the Greek National Anthem - 47, 104 or 158?	6. 158	6. 🇬🇷 The Greek National Anthem has 158 verses, making it the longest national anthem by number of verses — though usually only the first two are sung.
7. What does the Egyptian hieroglyph for 100,000 represent - A camel, A tadpole or A mummy	7. A tadpole	7. 🐸 In ancient Egypt, the tadpole symbol was used to represent 100,000 — likely because of their vast numbers in the Nile.
8. True or False: A flamingo can only eat when its head is upside down.	8. True	8. 🦩 Flamingos eat with their heads upside down to use their unique beak shape and filtering system properly. Right-side-up feeding doesn't work for them!
9. In which musical key do houseflies hum - B minor, C or F?	9. F	9. 🪰 Houseflies produce a hum in the key of F by beating their wings around 190 to 250 times per second.
10. True or False: A mosquito can support 23 times its own weight on each leg while standing on water.	10. True	10. 🦟 Mosquitoes can support 23 times their body weight on each leg, thanks to water's surface tension and their lightweight structure.
11. Two-thirds of all eating out in the UK happens at which type of restaurant - Fish and Chip, Indian or Chinese?	11. Indian	11. 🍛 Indian cuisine has become the UK's most popular takeaway choice, with two-thirds of all eating out happening at Indian restaurants.
12. True or False: Cutting your hair helps it grow back thicker and faster.	12. False	12. ✂️ Cutting your hair does not make it grow back faster or thicker — it only appears that way because trimmed ends look fuller.
