- 3. Taboo 🌷 Tom Hardy partly based Delaney's voice in Taboo on a fox's growl—according to him!
- 4. Sir Philip Redmond CBE 📮 Phil Redmond created Grange Hill at just 33 years old.
- 5. The Tourist 🚜 The Tourist was filmed in the Australian outback, where temperatures often exceeded 40°C.
