
## DID YOU KNOW?



# DID YOU KNOW?

A prehistoric creature is named after David Attenborough. The Attenborosaurus conybeari (a marine reptile) and even a 430-million-year-old fossilized crustacean (Cascolus ravitis) honor his contributions to natural history.

Oavid Attenborough is the only person to have won a BAFTA for programs in black-and-white, color, HD, 3D, and 4K. Attenborough quite literally spanned every major era of broadcast technology.
