FUN FACTS

- Anthony Hopkins appears on screen for surprisingly little time — yet Hannibal Lecter remains one of cinema's most chilling villains.
- The Haunting in Connecticut is loosely based on a supposedly true story, though its accuracy has been widely debated.
- Saying Candyman's name five times symbolises the power of belief — and the danger of curiosity.
- The infamous typed pages in *The Shining* were recreated in multiple languages for international releases.
- Smile went viral thanks to unsettling marketing stunts featuring grinning strangers at live sporting events.
- Doctor Sleep cleverly blends Stephen King's sequel novel with elements from Kubrick's original ending.
- Bird Box* became such a phenomenon it inspired risky online challenges that Netflix publicly warned against.
- Beetlejuice uses Charades because he can't say his own name — loopholes are his speciality.
- Lupita Nyong'o created completely different voices and movements to distinguish both versions of her character.
- Long before superstardom, Steve McQueen battled a blob made of silicone and red dye.
- The xenomorph was designed by artist H. R. Giger — and still haunts sci-fi nightmares decades later.
- Stephen King has said the story taps straight into childhood fears — clowns just got the worst reputation imaginable.
