FUN FACTS

- Chris Evans originally auditioned for multiple comic roles before landing Steve Rogers — including a certain flame-powered Fantastic Four hero.
- Black Panther was the first superhero film ever nominated for the Academy Award for Best Picture.
- The Flash's comic book debut was way back in 1940 — but that was actually a different Flash with a winged helmet.
- Jim Carrey based parts of his Riddler performance on the 1960s TV version — and deliberately cranked the energy to maximum.
- The Marvels is one of the shortest MCU films — proving even superheroes sometimes keep it fast and punchy.
- Jeffrey Wright is the first Black actor to portray Commissioner Gordon in a live-action movie.
- Storm was one of the first major Black female superheroes to headline in a modern blockbuster franchise.
- Marisa Tomei is the youngest actor to play Aunt May — a big shift from the traditionally elderly comic version.
- Catwoman first appeared in 1940 — and was originally known simply as "The Cat."
- The Shadow began on radio before comics and film — with the famous line: "Who knows what evil lurks in the hearts of men?"
- Dave Bautista insisted Drax be played as ultra-serious — which is exactly why his lines land so funny.
- Ryan Reynolds has said Green Lantern taught him what not to do — lessons he later used to shape Deadpool.
