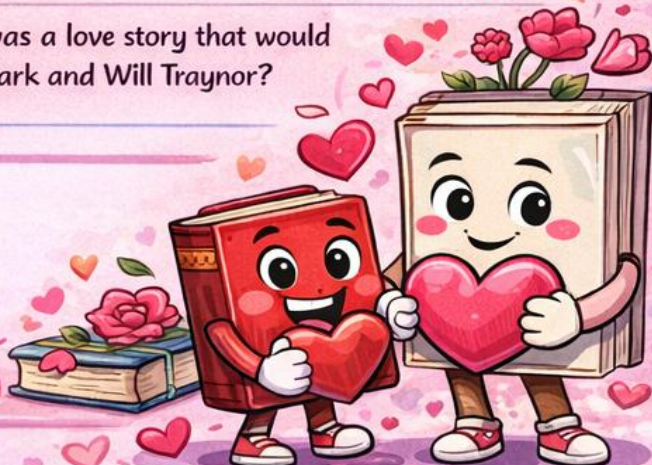

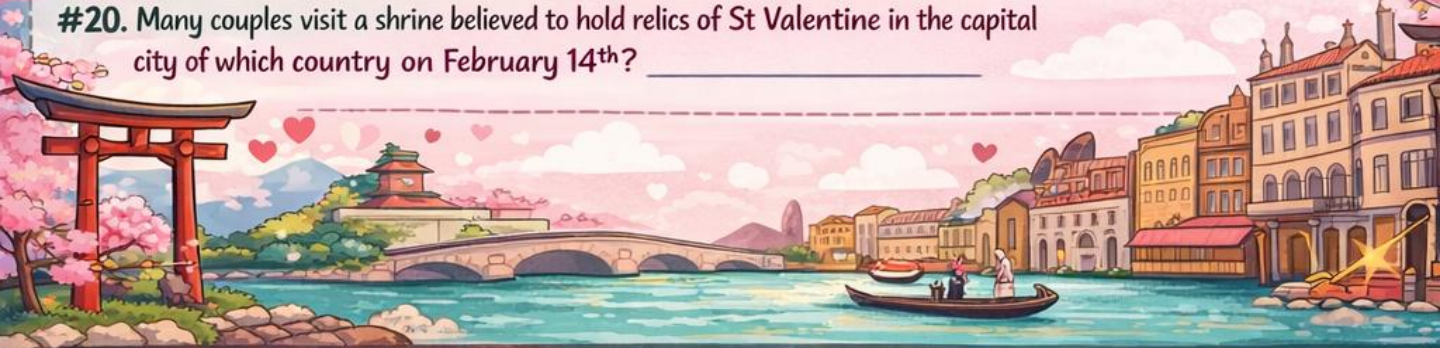

♥ **Chocolate boxes** were first popularised for Valentine's Day in the **1860s** by Richard Cadbury.



♥ An estimated **250 million roses** are grown for Valentine's Day every year.

♥ The **oldest** known Valentine message dates back to **1415** and was written from prison in the Tower of London.



♥ Roughly **1 in 5 marriage proposals** happens on or around Valentine's Day.



♥ In medieval Europe, people believed **birds chose** their mates on February 14th — helping link the date with romance.

♥ **Conversation hearts** were originally medical lozenges before becoming sweets with messages.



♥ **Red roses** are associated with Valentine's Day because they were said to be the **favourite flower of Venus**, the Roman goddess of love.



♥ Valentine's Day is one of the busiest days of the year for dating **apps** and online matchmaking.



♥ **Teachers** receive more Valentine's cards than anyone else — after partners and children.
