1. 🍷 The infamous campfire scene in *Blazing Saddles* featured the cast actually eating real baked beans, which director Mel Brooks later joked made filming the scene a little too authentic.
2. 🎵 Ennio Morricone composed much of the music for *Once Upon a Time in the West* before filming even began, allowing Sergio Leone to play the soundtrack on set during scenes.
3. 🎶 "Raindrops Keep Fallin' on My Head" won the Academy Award for Best Original Song, even though some critics initially thought it felt too modern for a Western.
4. 🏆 *Unforgiven* won Best Picture, Best Director (Clint Eastwood), Best Supporting Actor (Gene Hackman) and Best Film Editing at the Oscars.
5. 🐻 Leonardo DiCaprio finally won his first Academy Award for *The Revenant*, famously enduring freezing conditions and eating raw bison liver during filming.
6. 🎤 In *Riders of Destiny*, John Wayne's singing voice was actually dubbed by singer Smith Ballew, meaning the future Duke mostly lip-synced his cowboy songs.
7. 🐮 The title *8 Seconds* refers to the eight seconds a rider must stay on a bucking bull to receive a score in professional rodeo competitions.
8. 💰 Kevin Costner reportedly invested tens of millions of dollars of his own money to help finance the ambitious *Horizon* Western film series.
9. ⭐ The success of *Rio Bravo* inspired two similar John Wayne Westerns from the same director — *El Dorado* and *Rio Lobo*.
