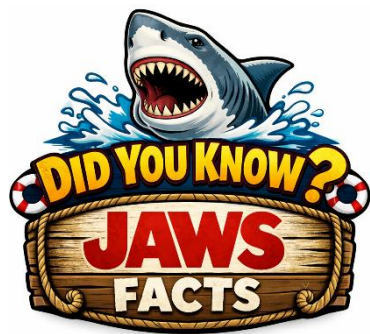

🎬 The mechanical shark used in filming was nicknamed "**Bruce**", after director Steven Spielberg's lawyer — and it broke down so often it nearly sank the entire production.

🌀 Because the shark kept malfunctioning, Spielberg was forced to show it less — accidentally making the film far more suspenseful.

🎵 The iconic two-note theme was composed by John Williams — and Spielberg initially thought it was too simple... until he realised how terrifying it was.

📍 The film was shot on location at Martha's Vineyard, making it one of the first major films to be filmed extensively in the open ocean rather than a studio tank.

🚢 The boat used by Quint, the Orca, actually sank for real during filming — forcing the crew to scramble and improvise.

💬 The famous line "You're gonna need a bigger boat" was not in the script — it became an inside joke on set before making it into the film.

📖 The film is based on a novel by Peter Benchley, who later became a shark conservation advocate after seeing the fear the story created.

🧠 The real-life inspiration behind the story came partly from the **1916 New Jersey shark attacks**, which shocked America at the time.

💰 The film went massively over schedule and budget, rising from around \$7 million to roughly \$9 million during production.

🎬 *Jaws* is widely credited as the **first summer blockbuster**, changing how films were marketed and released forever.

🦈 The shark itself is rarely seen in full during the film — a deliberate choice born from technical issues that ended up making it more terrifying.

🏆 The film won **three Academy Awards**, including Best Original Score, and was nominated for Best Picture.
