5. 🇺🇸 Easy Rider was made on a tiny budget but became a massive hit and helped launch the "New Hollywood" era of filmmaking.
6. 😂 Tony Curtis once claimed he based some of his comedy timing on watching fast-talking New Yorkers in diners.
