3. 🧟 Kim Dickens helped launch Fear the Walking Dead, proving that even before Rick Grimes had finished his zombie problems, television had found another corner of disaster to explore.
4. 🗣️ Matt Berry's booming voice is so distinctive he could probably read a takeaway menu and make it sound like gothic theatre.
5. 📚 The Demon Headmaster gave a whole generation trust issues with school assemblies, stern teachers, and anyone staring for slightly too long.
6. 🧟 Rick Grimes began as a sheriff and ended up as one of TV's most battered survivors — not exactly the career progression brochure promised.
7. 🧟 Cordelia Chase started as Sunnydale High royalty before getting dragged into vampires, demons, and the worst extracurricular programme imaginable.
8. 🧟 Thaddeus Montgomery is one of American Horror Story's more disturbing creations, which is saying something for a show that treats nightmares like a regular Tuesday.
9. 🐉 Pedro Pascal went from dragons and thrones to fungus monsters and emotional trauma, so clearly his agent enjoys prestige television with a high survival risk.
10. 🧟 The Neitherworld was basically Beetlejuice's home turf — a place so strange that even the afterlife seemed to have given up on normal planning permission.
