## ONE FOR THE BAR!

1. 🐟 Ichthyophobia comes from the Greek word *ichthys*, meaning fish — the same root used in the Christian "Jesus fish" symbol.
2. 🍳 Mageirocophobia can be linked to fears of undercooking food, setting fires, or simply embarrassing yourself in the kitchen!
3. 🍬 Chiclephobia gets its name from "chicle," the natural gum once used to make early chewing gum.
4. 🥚 Alfred Hitchcock once described eggs as "revolting" because of the way the yolk suddenly bursts when cracked open.
5. 🍌 Bananas are one of the world's most popular fruits, yet bananaphobia sufferers can panic at the smell, texture, or even seeing one nearby.
6. 💎 The scientific name for chocolate's mood-boosting compounds is partly why many people joke that xocolatophobia sounds completely irrational!
7. 🍷 Oenophobia comes from the Greek word *oinos*, meaning wine — the same origin behind the word "oenology," the study of wine.
8. 🍽️ Cibophobia can become so severe that sufferers avoid certain foods entirely over fears of contamination, illness, or spoilage.
9. 😬 Kakorrhaphiophobia often overlaps with perfectionism — meaning some sufferers avoid trying new things altogether.
10. 🍷 Methyphobia can involve a fear of alcohol itself or the fear of becoming intoxicated and losing control.
11. 🤢 Emetophobia is surprisingly common and can even make people avoid restaurants, travel, or pregnancy due to fear of vomiting.
12. 🐕 Cynophobia is one of the most common animal phobias in the world — even tiny dogs can trigger panic in severe cases.
