1. **Child Prodigy** 🧒 🎹 Stevie was blind shortly after birth due to retinopathy of prematurity, but he taught himself to play multiple instruments as a child. By age 7, he could play piano, harmonica, and drums.
2. **Early Stardom** 🌟 He was known as "Little Stevie Wonder" in his early Motown days. He signed with Motown's Tamla Records at age 11, making him one of the youngest artists ever to sign with a major label.
3. **First Hit** 🎤 🎵 His first hit, "Fingertips (Pt. 2)", was a live recording released in 1963, and it reached No. 1 on the Billboard Hot 100 when he was only 13.
4. **Multi-Instrumentalist** 🎸 🎺 🎹 Stevie can play over 10 instruments, including piano, harmonica, drums, bass, and synthesizers.
5. **Oscar Winner** 🏆 🎬 He won an Academy Award for Best Original Song in 1985 for "I Just Called to Say I Love You", which was part of the movie *The Woman in Red*.
6. **Activist & Advocate** 🗣️ 🌍 He has been a lifelong advocate for civil rights and humanitarian causes. In 1980, he helped campaign for Martin Luther King Jr. Day to become a national holiday. He has also spoken out for Nelson Mandela and other global human rights causes.
7. **Duets with Legends** 🎤 🤝 Stevie has performed with countless musical icons, including Paul McCartney, Julio Iglesias, Dionne Warwick, and Andrea Bocelli.
8. **Prolific Composer** 📄 🎵 He has released over 30 studio albums and written or co-written many of his hits, including "Superstition," "Sir Duke," and "Signed, Sealed, Delivered I'm Yours."
9. **Awards Galore** 🏆 🎵 Stevie Wonder has won 25 Grammy Awards, including a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award, making him one of the most awarded male solo artists in Grammy history.
10. **Touring Legend** 🚌 🌍 Even decades into his career, Stevie continues to tour. His "A Wonder Summer's Night" tour began in 2007 and included sold-out shows around the world.
