1. 🍷 Give It Away won the Red Hot Chili Peppers their first Grammy Award in 1993.
2. 🐙 Octopus's Garden is one of the few Beatles songs written by Ringo Starr, inspired after he learned that octopuses decorate their dens with shells and shiny objects.
3. 🎸 Wonderwall is the most-streamed song from the 1990s on Spotify.
4. ❤️ Although best known as a punk band, The Ramones reached No. 8 in the UK with their cover of "Baby, I Love You" in 1980. The song was originally recorded by The Ronettes in 1963.
5. 🎵 You Can't Hurry Love gave Phil Collins his first UK No. 1 single in 1982. The song was originally a Motown hit for The Supremes in 1966.
6. 🎬 Take On Me required three different music videos before becoming a worldwide smash hit.
7. 💙 Back for Good became Take That's only US Top 10 hit, reaching No. 7 on the Billboard Hot 100. Gary Barlow wrote the song in around 15 minutes while on tour.
8. 🚗 Cars was inspired by Gary Numan's road-rage encounter and became his first international hit, reaching No. 1 in the UK in 1979.
9. 🌙 Gimme! Gimme! Gimme! (A Man After Midnight) was never released on a studio album and later became the basis for Madonna's 2005 hit "Hung Up."
10. 📀 Bat Out of Hell has sold more than 43 million copies, making it one of the best-selling albums of all time.
11. 🎸 Free Bird was never released as a UK single, yet it remains Lynyrd Skynyrd's signature song thanks to its legendary four-minute guitar solo.
12. 🌻 California Dreamin' was written during a freezing New York winter while John and Michelle Phillips longed for the warmth and sunshine of California.
