3. 📀 Mika has sold more than 10 million records worldwide despite being best known to many younger viewers as a TV judge.
4. 📺 Gemma Collins became such a reality TV icon that she is often referred to simply as "The GC".
5. 🏉 Ugo Monye earned 14 caps for England and also represented the British & Irish Lions.
6. 🗨️ The phrase "soggy bottom" has become one of the most famous catchphrases in British television.
7. 👗 Georgia Kousoulou launched her own successful fashion brand after finding fame on reality TV.
8. 🏠 Katie Hopkins originally appeared on The Apprentice in 2007 but withdrew before the final due to pregnancy.
9. 🏃 Several celebrities suffered injuries on The Jump, leading to ongoing safety concerns about the show.
