LIFE ON MARS!

- 1** Life On Mars! takes its title from David Bowie's classic 1971 song, although the series itself is not based on the song's lyrics.
- 2** The series was originally intended to run for only two series. The writers planned Sam Tyler's story from the beginning, allowing the programme to reach a proper conclusion rather than being extended indefinitely.
- 3** Gene Hunt quickly became one of British television's most iconic detectives, with many of his unforgettable one-liners becoming fan favourites.
- 4** The production team paid meticulous attention to recreating 1973 Manchester, using period vehicles, costumes, shop fronts and props to capture the era as authentically as possible.
- 5** The show's ending deliberately leaves viewers questioning whether Sam Tyler's experiences were real, imagined, or something far more mysterious—a debate that continues among fans today.
- 6** Life On Mars! won widespread critical acclaim, including the BAFTA Television Award for Best Drama Series, and has since become regarded as one of Britain's greatest television dramas.



ASHES TO ASHES

- 1** Ashes to Ashes is named after another David Bowie song, continuing the musical connection established by Life On Mars!.
- 2** The series begins in 1981 and embraces the fashion, music and culture of the early 1980s, creating a striking contrast with the 1973 setting of Life On Mars!.
- 3** Gene Hunt, Ray Carling and Chris Skelton all return from Life On Mars!, making Ashes to Ashes a direct continuation of the story rather than simply a spin-off.
- 4** The final episode answers many of the mysteries surrounding Gene Hunt's world while also linking together the stories of both television series.
- 5** Throughout its three-series run, the programme became renowned for its carefully chosen soundtrack, featuring dozens of classic songs from the early 1980s.
- 6** Although Alex Drake is a forensic psychologist, she frequently clashes with Gene Hunt's instinctive, old-school policing methods, creating one of the show's defining relationships.
