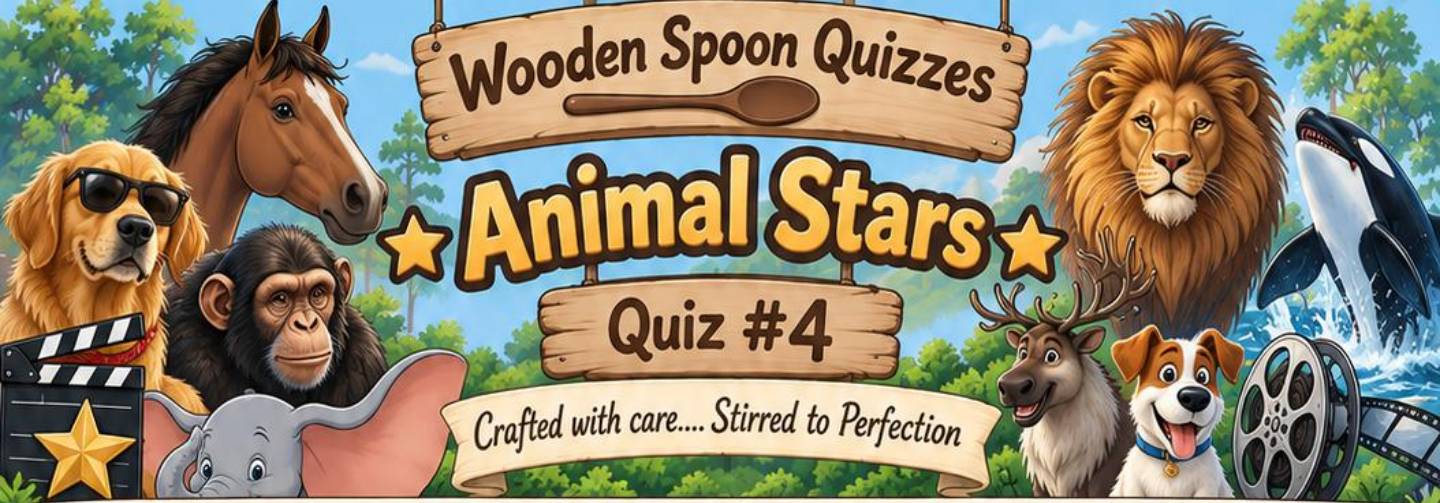

Lion



Aslan's name comes from the Turkish word for "lion," and author C. S. Lewis created him as a symbolic representation of Christ.
