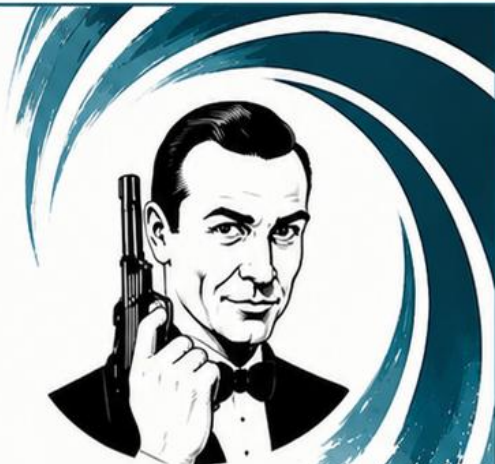

10 BOND FACTS

BEHIND THE SCENES FROM THE FIRST FIVE FILMS

1 Ursula Andress was cast as Honey Ryder in *Dr. No* just two weeks before filming her famous beach entrance. The scene was shot at Laughing Waters Beach in Jamaica — with Bond creator Ian Fleming actually present during filming.

2 Ian Fleming accidentally came close to appearing in *Dr. No*. Fleming and several companions wandered into the background while Honey Ryder's beach scene was being filmed and had to quickly get out of shot.

3 Filming *From Russia with Love* wasn't without danger. Director Terence Young was aboard a helicopter that crashed into the sea while scouting locations in Scotland. Everyone escaped with only minor injuries — and Young was back working later that same day.

4 The filmmakers were looking for a "young Greta Garbo" when casting Tatiana Romanova in *From Russia with Love*. The role eventually went to Italian actress and former Miss Universe runner-up Daniela Bianchi.

5 The Aston Martin DB5 supplied for *Goldfinger* was actually the first development prototype of the DB5. The filmmakers even cut into its roof to accommodate the famous ejector-seat effect.

6 The laser threatening Bond in *Goldfinger* wasn't producing the glowing beam seen in the finished film. A real laser was tried, but it disappeared under the studio lights, so the visible beam was added as an optical effect.

7 Sean Connery's fear during the shark-pool sequence in *Thunderball* became very real. A shark managed to get through the protective barrier separating him from the animals, forcing Connery to make a very rapid exit from the water.

8 The enormous underwater battle in *Thunderball* involved 45 divers. With no underwater radio communication available, the complicated action had to be rehearsed using hand signals and repeated above water whenever things became too complex.

9 Blofeld's spectacular volcano headquarters in *You Only Live Twice* was actually a gigantic Pinewood Studios set. It stood around 45 metres high, cost about \$1 million and could reportedly be seen from roughly five kilometres away.

10 Little Nellie from *You Only Live Twice* wasn't merely a film prop. The WA-116 autogyro was a genuinely flying aircraft, piloted for the film by its inventor, RAF Wing Commander Ken Wallis, with mock weapons added by the special-effects team.
